


Valleys of Adventure

At Avoca the Old School building in Boucher Park was restored by locals and opened on Australia Day, 26th January 2012 as the **Avoca Museum and Information Centre** showcasing local artworks and the history of this area where many families still carry the names of early European settlers.

Tranquil Tarn Ben Lomond

Visitors to Avoca are invited to take an alternate route to Fingal and enjoy the tall cool trees as they drive up the southern slopes of Ben Lomond to the once thriving mining town of Rossarden where fallow deer roam the streets. Hardworking locals painted the Community Centre, previously the school, and opened the **Rossarden and Storys Creek Museum** focusing on the mining history of this once vibrant town. The views of Ben Lomond are stunning. 5km further on is Craggy Peaks with its beautiful golf course and 16 luxurious cabins.

Eager mountain climbers can climb the southern slopes of Ben Lomond from either Storys Creek to Tranquil Tarn and Stacks Bluff, or approx 5km past the golf course turn left to commence the Bent Bluff climb.



Evercreech White Gum Board Walk

After descending Pepper Hill explore the beautiful valley town of Mangana and on to either the **Golden Gate Gallery** at Mathinna and the Evercreech forest where the 'White Knights', the tallest white gums in the world can be found on an easy five minute walk from a delightful picnic ground, or turn right and over the bridge to Fingal.

Or, the Old Coach Road will take you via Royal George to the coast with side trips to Hardings or Meetus Falls adventures to be enjoyed. The Old Coach Road is a fairly good gravel road from a few kms past Royal George to the coast road.
